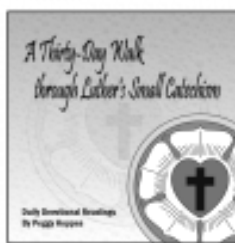
The Book of Ecclesiastes has a unique place in Scripture, reflecting on the life of faith with an honest and realistic perspective. It asks the hard questions of purpose and meaning in a world that often seems empty and vain.



From the perspective that Martin Luther called a *Theology of the Cross*, the questions and discussion in this study focus on our calling to take up our cross and follow Christ in faith "through this vain world."

This nine-session Bible study, written by Pastor Steven E. King, is intended for use by women's and men's groups, or for other small group fellowships gathering around the Word of God. It is the first in the Sola "group" series to use the newer expanded size, with three pages per lesson.
