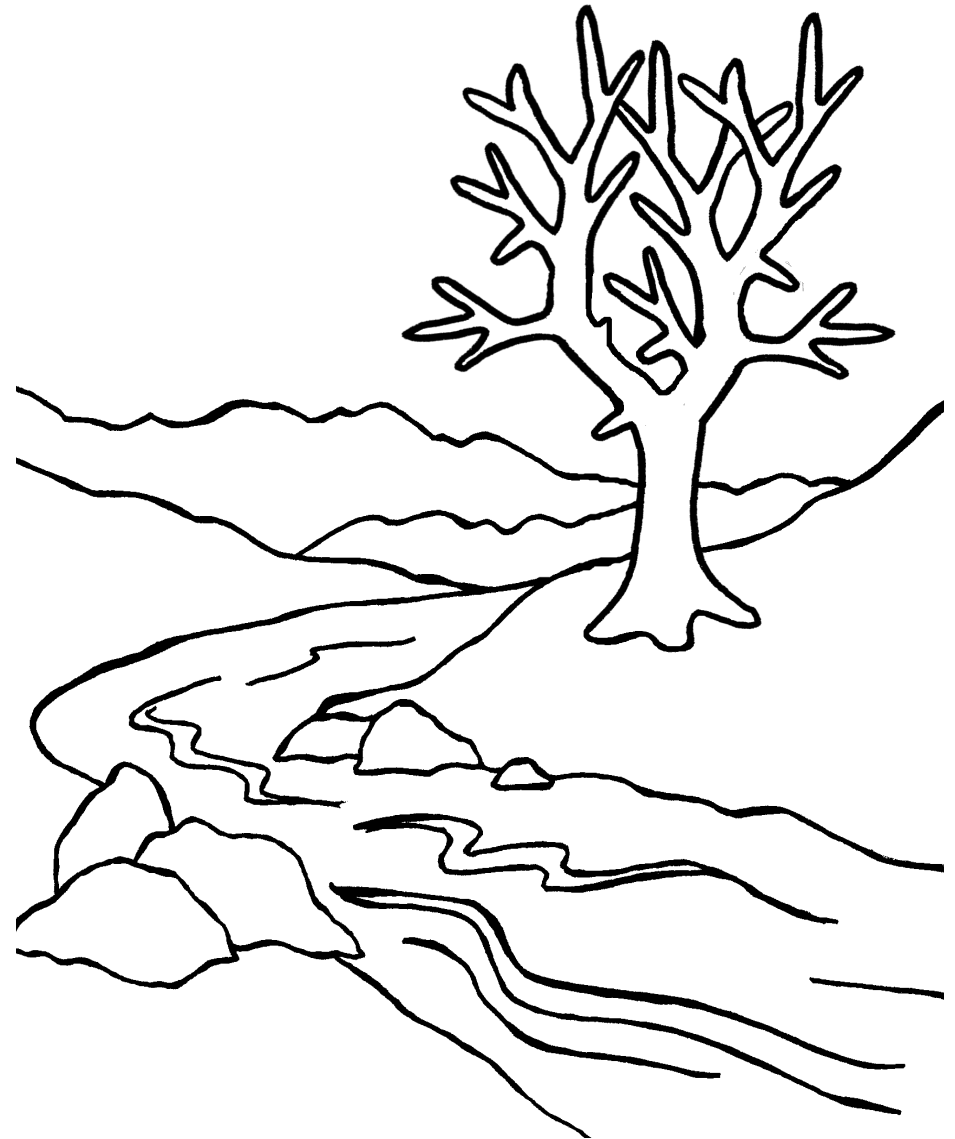

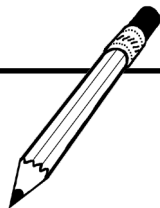
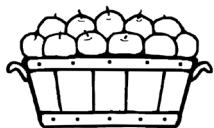
People are not much different.
