Message The night Jesus was crucified was a tough night for the people who loved him. Jesus tried to tell them that he had to die and everything was going to be okay, they didn't really understand. But then... it happened! (Build the excitement!) On Easter morning, two ladies went to see the tomb Where Jesus was buried. As they got there, there was an earthquake. The earth started shaking! And an angel came down from heaven and rolled the stone away and he sat there... right on the top of the stone... looking at the ladies. What? The ladies were very surprised and kind of afraid! The angel was super bright like lightning and his clothes shined very white whiter than snow. There were guards watching the tomb and it scared them so much they were shaking like the earthquake. No kidding! Then they fainted. Yep. They fell right down like they were asleep on the ground and they missed everything that happened next. The angel was there to talk to the ladies. He said, "Don't be afraid. I know you're looking for Jesus, but HE ISN'T HERE!" The ladies were shocked! What? He's not here? Then the angel said, "He has risen just as He said He would.
