These are people from my family: my Dad, Grandma and Grandpa Baker, and my Grandma and Grandpa Langhoff. This is my cousin, David, who went to be with Jesus when he was 19. This is my cousin's sweet little girl, Lorna, who was very sick and went to be with Jesus when she was 6. [To the congregation: Does anybody else have people they love in heaven?] I was very sad when these people went to heaven, but I was very happy that they were friends with Jesus, because it means I will see them again when I get to heaven someday. Until then, I have memories of them and silly pictures of them, even though I can't see them and they can't see me. Every once in a while, though, when I'm praying to Jesus, I'll say to Him, "Say HI to dad for me." It makes me feel good that I'll see all those people I love again in heaven. You know what else? I can't wait to see Noah, King David, and Jesus' disciples! They'll all be there too!
