Message One of today’s Bible readings says, Rejoice in the Lord, always; again I will say, rejoice! (Philippians 4:4) Who is the Lord? [Jesus] What does rejoice mean? It means to show great joy or happiness. The Bible is telling us to be happy in Jesus. Can we do that? What do you do when you’re happy? Do you smile? Clap your hands?
